Officer Trainees will arrive at the institute on or one day before the joining date. **Officer Trainees reporting after 9.30 AM on 29th April 2024 will not be allowed to join under any circumstances.**

Joining formalities – 29th April 2024 from 10:00am to 11.30 AM in Gandhi Hall, Ground floor at HIPA.

2. HOW TO REACH THE INSTITUTE:

The Institute in Gurugram is approx. 35 kms from Delhi. There are regular bus and taxi services from Delhi.

Nearest Bus Stand : Gurugram (5km); Delhi : ISBT, Kashmere Gate (40km); ISBT Anand Vihar (45km); Sarai Kale Khan (40km)

Nearest Rail heads: Gurugram (7km) & New Delhi (35km); Delhi (35km); Nizamuddin (30km)

Airport: Indira Gandhi International Airport (15km)

Nearest Metro Stations: MG Metro Station and IFFCO Chowk

The Institute is located near IFFCO CHOWK at the dividing road of Sector 17-18. It is located approx. 2 km from MG Metro and IFFCO Metro Station and 500 metres from IFFCO CHOWK. 3. RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION

During the Foundation Course, OTs are required to reside in the accommodation provided by the Institute. The rooms are fitted with air-conditioners.

Accommodation will be provided on a twin-sharing basis. NO request for change or choice would be entertained.

The rooms are provided with basic furniture (beds, mattress, chair, table and cupboard). OTs are requested to bring two sets of towels for their personal use. OTs may bring light Odhne Wali Single Layer Chadar as per their personal requirements. Items you are required to bring are listed in Annexure-I.

Accommodation for spouses or family members or children will NOT be provided. OTs are NOT allowed to entertain Guests (family members, friends, spouse or anybody

else) in their rooms. Therefore, do NOT bring any escorts with you at the time of joining. Institute will provide accommodation for OTs only.

4. DINING FACILITIES

Dining facilities are provided in the Officers' Mess. Cooking in hostel rooms is totally prohibited.

5. CLOTHING

The weather from April to August will be changes. April marks the beginning of the summer season from average temperature ranges between 30⁰ to 37°C. Light clothes are required during these periods.

6. LAPTOPS

The Institute will not provide laptops to Trainees. They are requested to carry personal laptops. However, for those who may not have laptops, the Institute has computer labs. A provision of one PC is also there in the hostel. OTs may use the facility. The campus is Wi-Fi enabled.

7. MOBILE PHONES

OTs are strictly prohibited from using mobile phones in the academic area.

8. CONSUMPTION OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC DRINKS/ TOBACCO

A trainee found in possession of alcoholic drinks or found to be in an inebriated condition will not be allowed to continue with the course. This will also invite disciplinary action against the OT under the relevant rules.

9. EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Extra – curricular activities will be organized by OTs .OTs may bring their personal gear for games, music and photography and indulge in their hobbies on special occasions.

10. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

The Foundation Course is a 'No Leave' course. **NO LEAVE SHALL BE GRANTED** during the period of training at the Institute. OTs are advised to settle/ dispose off the matters requiring their personal presence before joining the Institute.

Kindly bring sufficient money for the expenses with you.

11. DISCIPLINE

OTs are expected to maintain high standards of discipline and conduct in the campus.

12. PUNCTUALITY

OTs are always expected to be punctual whether it is the PT/ Yoga session in the morning or the academic sessions during daytime. Deviant behaviors may call for a disciplinary action.

LIST OF ITEMS REQUIRED

1. BEDDING & LINEN REQUIREMENT

Towels (Hand & Bath Towels with sufficient spares)
Light blanket/ light quilt as per personal needs

2. CLOTHING

The Institute lays strong emphasis on proper turnout. OTs are expected to be properly attired at all times and at no time should present an unkempt or slovenly appearance.

Gentlemen OTs must keep their hair trimmed short and properly groomed. They are required to shave daily. The OTs sporting moustaches and beards must keep them properly trimmed.

For the stay at Gurugram and excursions, OTs are advised to carry adequate clothing, both formal and informal and casual wear.

The following dress code is required to be observed by OTs -

a. Ceremonial/ Formal Occasions

Gentlemen OTs

It is mandatory for OTs to wear a formal full sleeves white shirt and black/ navy blue trousers and a necktie with formal shoes. The first such occasion would be the inauguration of the Foundation Course.

Lady OTs

Saree (in sober colors) with formal Shoes/ Sandals

b. Class

Gentlemen OTs

Full sleeve/ half-sleeve Shirt and Trousers with formal shoes

Lady OTs

Saree/ Salwar-Kameez/ Churidar-Kurta/ Western Business Suit with formal Shoes/ Sandals.

OTs are expected, to be well-groomed and properly attired at all times. Casuals or frivolous dress shall NOT be allowed during the academic hours or in the Officers' Mess.

Only formal leather shoes shall be worn in academic area, Officers' Mess, Officers' Lounge and Library. Sneakers, sports shoes and tennis shoes may be worn only as a part of PT /Games dress. Use of slip-ons/ leather chappals by Gentlemen and Lady OTs is strictly prohibited. **Use of bathroom slippers is restricted to hostel rooms only.**

c. For PT/ Yoga/ Games and Sports Activities

White T-shirts have to be worn for the mandatory PT/ Yoga and sports/ games activities. For other sporting activities, OTs may bring sports-clothes, of their own choice. A pair of good quality jogging/ running shoes (in white colors) with adequate cushioning for running will be required.

Lady OTs may bring two pairs of plain white salwar-kameez or wear tracksuit during PT/ Yoga/ Sports, according to their comfort-level.

OTs to bring two pairs of white socks preferably in white color.

OTs to bring their personal tracksuits for trekking and morning PT/ Yoga.

One pair of Tracksuit will be arranged by HIPA on payment basis and it is mandatory.

d. Trekking

A mandatory trek in the Himalayas of approx. 6-7days is an integral part of the Foundation Course. The treks touch a height of over 14,000 feet above the sea level. OTs may require adequate woolen clothing and footwear for the purpose of trekking.
